STUDENTS

- 2299 undergraduates; 31% women; 27% underrepresented populations
- 69/31% In-state/Out-of-state
- Class of 2014: 3,589 applications; 1,356 offers, 581 accepted
- SAT mean 1377 – verbal 656, math 721; 91% top 10% of Class
- 79 students studied, worked or served abroad in 2009-2010; 15% on track for an international experience
- 30% pursue a business minor; 23% hold minors in other areas; 13% graduate with a double major
- Students founded *The Spectra Engineering and Science Research Journal* (www.seas.virginia.edu/pubs/spectra)
- Six Jefferson Scholars in Class of 2014 (of a total of 27)
- Average starting salary for undergraduates in Class of 2010 was \$61,000
- Science and Technology Policy Program 10 years old; interns placed in Paris and Buenos Aires
- 615 graduate students, 80.8% in a Ph.D. program
